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This is the eighth edition of the *Baker & McKenzie International Arbitration Yearbook*, an annual series established by the Firm in 2007. This collection of articles comprises reports in key jurisdictions around the globe on arbitration. Leading lawyers of the Firm's International Arbitration Practice Group, a division of the Firm's Global Dispute Resolution Practice Group, report on recent developments in national laws relating to arbitration and address current arbitral trends and tendencies in the jurisdictions in which they practice.

For this 2014-2015 edition, the topic of Section C of each chapter is local arbitration institutions. Each jurisdiction sets out key features of its local institutions.

The aim of this *Yearbook* is to highlight the more important recent developments in international arbitration, without aspiring to be an exhaustive case reporter or a text-book to arbitration in the broad sense. It is hoped that this volume will prove a useful tool for those contemplating and using arbitration to resolve international business disputes.

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
