


PROCESS FLOWCHARTS







When there is no determination on the number of arbitrators in the arbitration agreement: A sole arbitrator will be appointed by default unless the EC finds that a Tribunal of three should be appointed after considering the sophisticated issues of the dispute. The arbitrator could be agreed by the parties of failing that, he could be appointed by the EC. The Centre transfers the case files to the Tribunal after checking that payment of fees has been fully made and all other preliminary procedures issues have been dealt with in accordance to the Rules. Following up the procedures with the Tribunal and replying to the any request made by the parties and arbitrators with decisions from the EC whenever that is needed. Receiving the final Arbitral Award from the arbitrator(s) Notifying the parties with copies of the award Either party may request for interpretation of the award A request for interpretation is made The Tribunal will have 30 days to give interpretation
